Position: Part-time Director of Music/Organist

The Director of Music is responsible for directing the traditional music program at Lighthouse Christ Presbyterian Church, Ormond Beach, Florida. The Director of Music reports directly to the Pastor and provides choral leadership and planning with experience in Presbyterian Hymnody, knowledge of traditional worship music, directs the Chancel choir at the traditional Sunday worship service and leads and directs the choir at scheduled rehearsals. As a professional, the Director of Music's position is salaried and part-time at 20 hours/ week.

Our primary instrument is a Casavant 2 Manual pipe organ installed in 1993.

## Qualifications (Education/Background)

1. Must be a committed follower of Jesus Christ.
2. Have a passion for Music Ministry while growing disciples
3. Bachelor's Degree or equivalent experience in some area of music preferred.
4. Previous successful experience in church music.

## Specific Knowledge and Skills

1. Communication skills and relationship building skills.
2. Good organizational and communication skills
3. Working knowledge of choral rehearsal techniques and conducting.
4. Openness to a wide variety of musical styles.
5. Computer proficient.

## Specific areas of responsibility:

1. This person will communicate with the Pastor to ensure that music selection is

appropriate for regularly scheduled and special services.

2. Under the direction of the Pastor, this person will coordinate planning, rehearsal, and implementation of music for traditional, unity and seasonal worship services.
3. Direct and lead rehearsals for adult traditional choir(s).
4. Under leadership of the Pastor, develop an overall plan for worship throughout the church year based on liturgical calendar and themes.
5. Hire guest soloists/instrumentalists for worship and other church events as needed or as directed. On a regular basis, hire professional instrumentalists or quartets to provide special music in worship. Find and provide special concert opportunities the church may host.
6. Provide music leadership for worship services, funerals, and weddings. Music leadership for funerals and weddings will be paid an additional honorarium from the family.
7. Provide for the care and upkeep of church musical instruments.
8. Continuing education is encouraged in consultation with the Pastor.

#### Compensation

\$25,000 – \$35,000 – Additional consideration would be given to someone who can accompany the choir on Organ and Piano.
