SUMMARY

All Saints Church is an historic episcopal church with a rich tradition of music in beautiful Winter Park, Florida. With a growing parish congregation, the All Saints Church mission is to "Proclaim the Gospel. Love One Another. Trust God."

The Parish Organist plays a key role in the fulfillment of that mission in collaboration with the Director of Music Ministry. The Parish Organist is responsible for providing keyboard music at the 9:00am and 11:15am Rite II Eucharist services on Sunday mornings, and serves as the accompanist for the St. Gregory Choir (adults) and Choristers (youth). Additional opportunities for professional growth include leadership in a new Center for Sacred and Early Music.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

- Provide keyboard music on Sundays at the 9:00am and 11:15am Rite II Eucharist.
- Accompany the St. Gregory Choir at Wednesday rehearsals from 7:00-9:00pm and at Sunday morning services.
- Accompany the Choristers (youth) and assist the Director of Music with implementation of the RSCM Voice for Life program at Wednesday rehearsals beginning at 5:00 PM.
- Provide keyboard music and accompany the St. Gregory Choir for monthly evensong services (5:00 PM, first Sunday of the month September-May).
- Provide keyboard music and accompany the St. Gregory Choir at special parish liturgies (e.g. All Saints Day, Advent Lessons & Carols, Ash Wednesday, Wednesday noon services in Lent, Holy Week, Ascension Day).
- Direct the St. Gregory Choir on the rare occasion the Director of Music and Choral Associate are both absent and there is no other substitute.
- First right of refusal to play for funerals and weddings. These services come with an additional honorarium (number of services per year varies; 16 in the last year).

- Schedule a supply organist to cover when absent.
- Maintain a consistent organ practice schedule.
- Be a positive, collaborative, and supportive colleague to parish clergy and staff.
- Other duties as assigned.

COMPENSATION

The Parish Organist salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

ADDITIONAL INCOME OPPORTUNITIES

On Campus

- Use of the church facility for private teaching (organ lessons, piano lessons, etc.)
- Collaboration with the Director of Music in developing a new concert series, monthly Bach's Lunch concerts, and a new Center for Sacred and Early Music (potential for additional stipend in the future as these programs develop).

In the Community

- Supply organist for weddings and funerals in Central Florida.
- Collaborative pianist for local school and community chorus concerts and vocal/ instrumental Solo & Ensemble festivals.
