OVERVIEW

The organist plays a vital role in the music ministry of Wekiva Presbyterian Church by providing musical support to worship services, rehearsals, and special music events, which require an organist or piano accompanist. This is a part-time position (approximately 10 hours per week).

Primary Responsibilities

- Play for all worship services, including one Sunday morning worship service, and special services on Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday, and other special services as planned by the Worship Committee.
- Choose appropriate music for preludes, postludes, offertories, and other portions of worship services.
- Attend regular and special practices of the choirs.
- Appropriately use and care for the church organ and piano.
- Play for funerals and weddings as available.
- Play for other church-sponsored musical events and practices, as needed.
- Serve as a substitute in the absence of the Director of Music and Worship Arts.
- Promote an atmosphere of collaboration and support among all participants in the music program.

Qualifications

- A committed Christian in attitude, belief, words, and deeds with an understanding of the role of music ministry within the church ministry.
- An accomplished organist and pianist with good sight-reading and accompanying skills.
- Appreciation for all church music styles, with an understanding of worship dynamics.
- Committed to a team concept of ministry.

Salary: \$12,000 - \$14,000 per year depending on qualifications.

Instruments:

The church has a digitally mastered, 3-manual Renaissance Allen Organ (model R-370). It was installed in October of 1999 and dedicated by Diane Bish in 2000.

The sanctuary piano is a 6' Kawai, KG-2D. This organist can offer music lessons using the church facilities and instruments as the WPC schedule permits.
