GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

The primary responsibility of the choir director is to co-direct and co-facilitate the music programs of First Presbyterian Church in conjunction with the director of the praise team and bell choir. The choir director will recruit and train volunteers for the chancel choir. The choir will be under the supervision of the Pastor and Session. The position will be reviewed yearly by the pastor and personnel committee.

- Work to develop/expand the music ministry of the church
- Responsible for assigning an anthem for weekly and special services
- Provide solo performance according to skill when necessary
- Administer the Worship/Music budget with the Worship Team
- Attend weekly staff meetings
- Other duties as designated by the pastor

- Worship concerts and series outside of the weekly worship service
- Christmas and Easter services, high holy days such as Maundy Thursday and Good Friday
- Manage and supplement the church music library
- Attend special events deemed important to the life of the church
