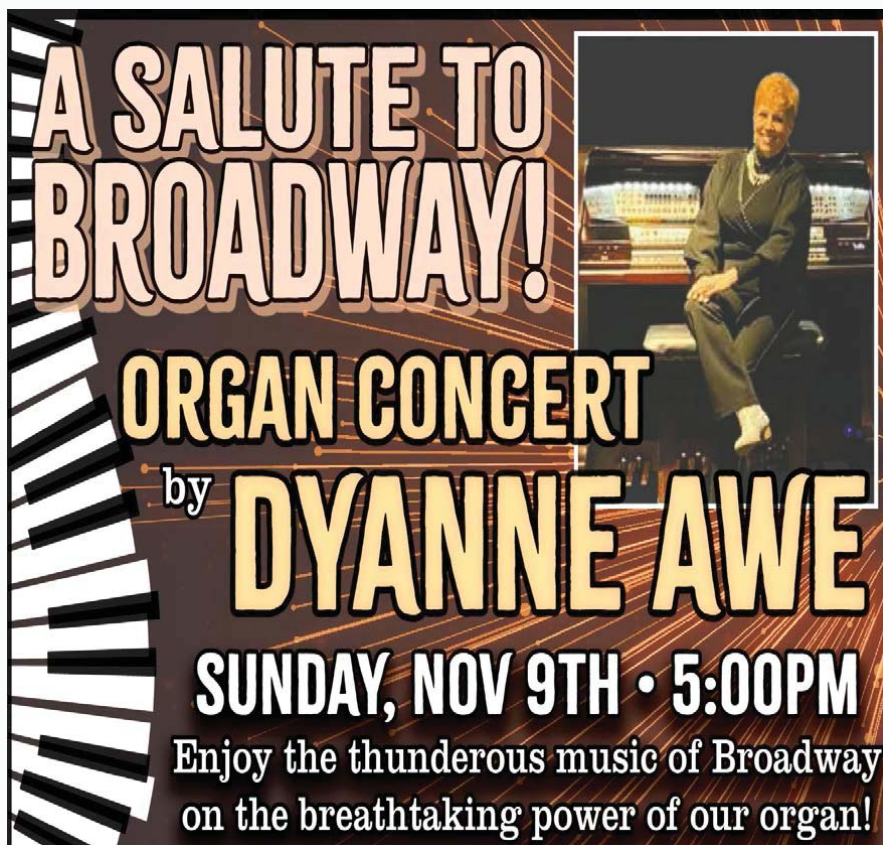
St. George Concert Series Presents: A Salute to Broadway!
